Task	Status
Choose and book a reliable removals company (like Removals Expert Ltd.)	
Set your official moving date	
Notify your landlord or property manager (if renting)	
Begin decluttering each room — donate, sell, or dispose	
Take measurements of furniture and your new space	
Start organizing important documents (passports, lease, bills)	
Inform schools of your child's move and transfer records

Task	Status

Notify utility providers (gas, electric, water, broadband) of your move	
Notify insurance providers and banks of address change	
Organize important files in a folder for the move	
Schedule a professional cleaning service, if required	
Start using up food in your freezer and pantry	
Arrange care for pets or small children on moving day	
Notify friends and family of your new address	

### ☒ 2 Weeks Before Moving

Task	Status
Confirm <a href="#">booking</a> with your removal company	
Arrange disconnection and reconnection of services (TV, broadband)	
Finalize change of address with DVLA, HMRC, and other services	
Pack guest room, garage, and other low-use spaces	
Arrange for parking permits at both addresses if needed	
Dispose of hazardous materials (paint, oil, batteries, etc.)	
Start dismantling large furniture (beds, tables)	
Clean garden tools and outdoor equipment	
Take photos of current home condition (rented property proof)	
Check your new home is clean and ready for move-in	
Print out maps, directions, and logistics for moving day	

### ☒ 1 Week Before Moving

Task	Status
Pack remaining non-daily use items	
Prepare a moving day essentials kit (clothes, toiletries, snacks)	
Finalise and review inventory checklist	
Defrost and clean the fridge/freezer	
Confirm arrangements with the removals team	
Check weather forecast and plan accordingly	
Reconfirm address and time with utility companies	
Arrange deep cleaning for old property	
Empty loft, shed, and storage spaces	
Ensure tools and supplies (screwdriver, tape, cutters) are accessible	
Secure all valuables and personal items to move separately	

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## ☒ Moving Day

Task	Status
Wake up early and double-check moving schedule	
Pack bedding, chargers, and personal care items last	
Welcome and guide the removals team	
Make sure all boxes are clearly labeled	
Supervise final furniture dismantling and loading	
Keep important documents and valuables with you	
Take final meter readings (gas, water, electric)	
Leave keys with landlord or new owner as agreed	
Double-check cupboards, drawers, and garden for forgotten items	
Lock all windows and doors	
Celebrate — you made it through moving day!

Begin unpacking essentials and bedroom items	
Check that all utilities are working properly	
Register at your local GP and dentist	
Reconnect and test broadband and devices	
Confirm your address change with all subscriptions and services	
Inspect your belongings for any damage during transit	
Set up smoke detectors and security systems	
Clean and sanitize your new home	
Organize boxes by room and unpack systematically	
Introduce yourself to neighbours	
Leave a review for your removals company!
